

AN INSIDER'S GUIDE TO CONTACTING YOUR STATE LEGISLATOR

Garden Club of Virginia Conservation and Beautification Committee's Virtual Advocacy Tips

Before Getting Started

- 1. **Know GCV Legislative Positions**. Familiarize yourself with the current *Garden Club of Virginia Legislative Statement*. - 2. Know the names, background, and contact information for your state Senator and Representative. You may look this up at: https://whosmy.virginiageneralassembly.gov.

Contact Your State Legislator

- 3. If requesting an appointment to advocate for our issues (telephone conversation or Zoom/FaceTime call for example), <u>See sample email for this purpose</u>. Keep in mind, the Senator's or Representative's Legislative Aides are extremely helpful and knowledgeable and will be providing guidance to the Legislator.
- 4. **Introduce yourself and the GCV** (the size and impact of our organization to the Commonwealth of Virginia). Be sure to say if you are their constituent.
- 5. **Focus your message** (a few sentences for social media or a few short paragraphs for a telephone or Zoom conversation).
- 6. Have a personal connection or story relating to the issue to share.
- 7. If time permits, ask the Legislators what Conservation issue is of most concern to them and how we might be of help.
- 8. **Thank them** for their time and work on behalf of the environment. A follow-up note is always appreciated.
