Well-written and well-researched articles are further enhanced by good quality, high-resolution photos designed to strengthen the Journal's overall impact and aesthetic. Please review the following quidelines:

- The *Journal* welcomes submissions by GCV committees, clubs, and club members, as well as article ideas related to the organization's mission and its initiatives and events. Additionally, the *Journal* welcomes article ideas.
- As a matter of editorial policy, all submissions will be edited for clarity of expression, space, accuracy, style compliance, grammar, syntax, structure and messaging.
- The Journal adheres to the AP Stylebook (Associated Press Stylebook, 55th Edition, 2020) and Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary.
- Unsolicited material will be considered, but submission does not guarantee publication.
- Prior to writing or submitting an article, it is highly recommended contacting either the *Journal* editor or your GCV District *Journal* Liaison. Contact information is listed below.
- SNIPS is a section in the *Journal* that highlights the work of GCV clubs and committees. For more information, see following page.
- All writers are expected to thoroughly fact check, spell check and proofread their submissions, including all proper names, dates, events, etc.
- All submissions must include a title, byline, author's club and GCV position, if relevant.
- All articles must be submitted in Word and emailed as attachments to the *Journal* editor Please do not submit as pdfs, in Pages, Notes or as text in an email.
- Please adhere to deadlines indicated on the following page.

PHOTO SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

Photos equally drive the *Journal's* content. All submissions must be accompanied by good quality, suitable photos that appropriately illustrate the article. All photos must be at least 1 MB and can be horizontal or vertical orientations. iPhone shots are welcome as long as they are emailed as "actual size." Several photos should be submitted with each article. A caption (containing details describing the photo) and photo credit (identifying the photographer) must accompany each photo.  Journal editor prior to submitting. Maximum word count is 700 and must be accompanied
 by good quality, high resolution photos (1 MB minimum).
- Club articles: Articles on the work of GCV clubs are highly encouraged. Events, projects and programs that have recently occurred will be considered for publication. Submissions should be coordinated with GCV District *Journal* Liaisons, and contacting them prior to submitting an article is advised. Word count maximum is 225; all submissions must be accompanied by good quality, high resolution photos (1 MB minimum).
