

Historic Garden Week Petersburg Tour 2026



In 1980, the Old Towne Historic District earned a place on the National Register of Historic Places. Spanning 190 acres and featuring 250 buildings, the district showcases a rich blend of residential, commercial, and industrial architecture from the 19th and early 20th centuries.

Today's tour highlights five distinctive examples of this architectural variety: Federal, Italianate, Egyptian Revival, a traditional stone house, and a historic duplex. As you ride the City trolley from one stop to the next, take in the character and craftsmanship that define this remarkable area.
