

## 2026 GCV Daffodil Collection - American Bred

In recognition of America's 250th birthday, GCV's 2026 daffodil collection presents cultivars by American breeders. From Oregon and California to three Virginia-bred blooms, all of these cultivars are eligible for the American Bred classes and the ADS Red, White, and Blue ribbon. Celebrate America!



### **Androcles 4 W-W registered by Bill Pannill**

A beautiful strong growing standard. Fully double with white petals and a creamy white center. Mid-to-late spring.



### **Bittern 12 Y-O registered by Grant Mitsch**

Part of his Bird Series, named after the bird Bittern which has unusual calls and lives in the marches of Oregon. This bloom has lemon yellow perianth segments, 1-2 florets per stem and a bright orange corona. Sweet, lovely fragrance. Mid-to-late spring.



### **Golden Echo 7 WWY-Y registered by Brent Heath**

A long golden yellow cup melts down on to creamy white petals. Wonderfully fragrant and a long lasting bloom. May be 1-2 florets per stem.



### **Martinette 8 Y-O registered by Harry Tuggle, Jr.**

Virtually a bouquet on a stem with 4-5 florets. The perianth segments are broadly ovate, blunt and lemon yellow, stained pale orange at base. Early to mid spring.



### **Mesa Verde 12 G-GGY registered by Robert Spotts**

A unique green daffodil, long lasting flowers open green with a yellow tinge. Usually two florets per stem. Early-to-mid spring.

## GCVA 2026 'Celebrating 250 Years Collection' - Item # 47-0155

The following daffodils make up GCVA's 2026 'Celebrating 250 Years Collection':

N. 'Golden Echo' (7WWY-Y); N. 'Androcles' (4W-W); N. 'Martinette' (8Y-O);  
N. 'Bittern' (12Y-O); and N. 'Mesa Verde' (12G-GGY)

1. All collections will have 3 of each item packaged and labeled individually.
2. Each participant may order individually, with friends or as a club.
3. Each collection will cost \$38.00. So 1 = \$38.00 or 10 = \$380.00.
4. All orders need to have a 6.3% sales tax added (1 = \$2.39)
5. If one collection is ordered (\$38), the minimum shipping charge is \$7.00.
6. If two or more collections are ordered together, the shipping charge is 10% of the total amount for bulbs.  
{i.e. 2 x \$38 = \$76 + \$4.79 (sales tax) + \$7.60 shipping = \$88.39  
OR 10 x \$38 = \$380 + \$23.94 (sales tax) + \$38 shipping = \$441.94}
7. Please order EARLY - it is possible for the bulbs to run out - and we can't make more!
8. Not eligible for 'Bloomin' Bucks'
